



Cities Going Green: Development of a Green and Smart City

The consortium of the project “Cities Going Green: Development of a Green and Smart City” (Erasmus+ KA2) has successfully carried out the first 4 activities of the project, as part of Project Result 1: Theoretical Framework. These activities were the following:

Activity 1: Desk research

Activity 2: Focus groups with teachers and analysis

Activity 3: Focus groups with pupils and analysis

Activity 4: Focus groups with experts and analysis

During the first activity, the partners were able to trace good practices for environmental sustainability in each one of the 5 partner countries (Poland, Cyprus, Estonia, Greece, Spain). Various practices, policies and tools were identified and presented by the partners.

The next set of activities included three rounds of focus groups in each country, engaging three different target groups: teachers of pupils 10-12 years old, pupils 10-12 years old and experts on topics that are related to environmental sustainability and natural resource management. The information obtained by these three target groups will be utilized for the creation of an electronic game which will be attractive and easy-to-use for pupils at the age 10-12.

The next steps of the project include the preparation of an aggregate report consisting of all the collected information throughout the first 4 activities, as well as the development of the theoretical framework and the learning outcomes of the game.
